The New York State Perinatal Association's Annual Perinatal Partnership Conference is the *premier* maternal/infant/child health professional education conference in New York State, traditionally drawing an average of 200 - 250 health and human service providers and professionals from across the state.

#### **Submission Timeline/Deadline:**

**Plenary & Workshop sessions:** The committee will begin reviewing proposals in October 2018 and will continue doing so until the agenda is complete. We expect to complete the competitive review process and select all sessions no later than 2/15/18.

**Poster abstracts** can be submitted anytime between 11/15/17 and 4/1/18. Posters should be identified as to which category to be considered for. Abstracts will be peer reviewed for acceptance.

### **Acknowledgement & Notification:**

All submissions will be acknowledged within 48 hours to confirm receipt and completeness. Plenary and Workshop Proposals will be reviewed monthly and assigned a ranking. Selection decisions will begin being made by 10/31/17 and continue monthly until agenda is complete. Presenters will be notified either upon selection or by 2/28/18. Presenters MUST complete and return an acceptance agreement (including continuing education documentation) no later than 3/30/18. Any selected session for which the presenter does not complete the acceptance agreement will be withdrawn from the program and replaced with an alternative presentation and speaker.

<u>Poster Abstracts</u> will be reviewed on a rolling basis and no later than 4/15/18, with authors notified by 4/30/18. Poster authors MUST complete and return an acceptance agreement no later than 5/15/18 with a reservation fee of \$25. The \$25 fee is to cover the cost of the board rental, but will be credited to the (one) author's conference registration fee. <u>Any poster for which the author does not complete the acceptance agreement and submit the \$25 fee by 5/15/18 will be withdrawn from the program.</u>
